STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to provide for securing the rights of mortgage bondholders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The provision of the revised statutes, chapter fifty-2 one, section forty-seven to seventy each inclusive, are

- 3 so far amended as to apply to and include all mortgages
- 4 of franchises, lands or other hereditaments, or of all
- 5 of them heretofore or hereafter given by any corpo-
- 6 ration to trustees to secure scrip or bonds of said
- 7 corporation, so that the holder of said scrip or bonds
- 8 may have the benefit of all said provision whether the
- 9 said mortgages have been or may be foreclosed in the
- 10 manner provided by section fifty-three of said chapter,
- 11 or in any other legal manner, and to it extent of,

12 and with reference to the property covered by the

13 mortgage. The new corporation when organized, shall

14 have all the rights and privileges of the original corpo-

15 ration.
