STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to authorize cities and towns to charge interest on certain taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Whenever a city or town has fixed a time

- 2 within which taxes assessed therein shall be paid, such
- 3 city, by its city council, and such town, at the meet-
- 4 ing when money is appropriated or raised, may vote
- 5 that on all taxes remaining unpaid after a certain
- 6 time, interest shall be paid at a specified rate, not
- 7 exceeding one per centum per month; and the interest
- 8 accruing under such vote or votes shall be added to,
- 9 and be a part of such taxes.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
