STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT additional to and amendatory of section fiftyfive, chapter one hundred and thirteen of revised statutes, in relation to the support of debtors in jail.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section fifty-five of chapter one hundred 2 and thirteen of the revised statutes is hereby amended, 3 by the addition of the following words: When a 4 debtor is committed to prison on mesne process or 5 execution, the creditor committing said debtor shall 6 advance to the jailor pay for one week's board of said 7 debtor.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
