STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-five of the revised statutes, relating to the distribution of the estates of persons deceased out of the state.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter sixty-five of the revised statutes is hereby 2 amended, by adding thereto the following section : 3 Sect. 39. Where lands in this state held in trust 4 under a foreign will, for persons non-resident here, 5 have been sold, the probate court for the county in 6 which the will has been allowed may, in its discretion, 7 order the money to be transmitted to the trustee, if 8 there is any, in the state or country where the testator 9 had his domicil.
