STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE laying a tax on the several counties of the
state.

Resolved, That the sums annexed to the counties in
2 the following schedule, are hereby granted as a tax
3 on each county respectively, to be appropriated, as-
4 sessed, collected and applied for the purpose of paying
5 the debts and necessary expenses of the same, and
6 other expenses ordered by law, to wit: Androscog-
7 gin, thirty thousand dollars; Aroostook, thirteen thou-
8 sand five hundred dollars; Cumberland, seventy-one
9 thousand eight hundred and sixty dollars; Franklin,
10 four thousand dollars; Hancock, twelve thousand dol-
11 lars; Kennebec, forty thousand dollars; Knox, eigh-
12 teen thousand dollars; Lincoln, ten thousand dollars;
13 Oxford, twelve thousand dollars; Penobscot, fifty
14 thousand dollars; Piscataquis, six thousand dollars;

15 Sagadahoc, sixteen thousand dollars; Somerset, thir-
16 teen thousand five hundred dollars; Waldo, eighteen
17 thousand dollars; Washington, fifteen thousand dol-
18 lars; York, twenty-five thousand dollars.
