STATEMENT OF FACTS ACCOMPANYING HOUSE DOCU-MENT No. 18.

The building erected last year is unfurnished, and it is estimated will cost twenty-eight hundred and twenty-five dollars to furnish the same.

To complete the furnishing of the chapel wards, it is estimated will require five hundred and seventy-five dollars.

There is need of increased ventilation in portions of the hospital building, also need of a larger supply of water, and the adoption of some system for the protection of the buildings in case of fire. These wants the officers think they will be able to supply if repayment is made of the amount expended last year from hospital fund for new boilers.
