IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT relating to the appointment of land agent and his duties.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

It shall be the duty of the governor, with the advice

- 2 of council, to appoint the land agent, who shall hold
- 3 his office during their pleasure; and it shall be his
- 4 duty under their direction, as speedily as the public
- 5 good allows, to bring to a termination all unsettled
- 6 business connected with the land office, relating to the
- 7 lands belonging to the state, to the end that the office
- 8 may be discontinued at the earliest practicable
- 9 moment.
