STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend section one hundred and seventeen of chapter eighty-two of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one hundred and seventeen of chapter eighty-2 two is hereby amended, so as to read as follows:

3 Sect. 117. When a plaintiff brings divers suits at 4 the same term of a court against the same party, 5 which might have been joined in one, or divides an 6 account that might all have been sued for in one 7 action, and commences successive suits upon parts of 8 the same, or brings more than one suit on a joint and 9 several contract, he shall recover costs in only one of 10 them, and on only one of the judgments shall exe-11 cution run against the body of the same defendant, 12 unless the court, after notice to the defendant, and13 hearing, certifies that there was good cause for com-14 mencing them.
