## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT additional to chapter two hundred and twentythree of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-one, regulating railroad corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The provisions of section one of chapter
- 2 two hundred and twenty-three of the public laws of
- 3 eighteen hundred and seventy-one, shall not be con-
- 4 strued to prevent railroad corporations from estab-
- 5 lishing necessary rules and regulations for the cancel-
- 6 lation of tickets and exchange of partially used tickets,
- 7 such rules and regulations to be publicly posted at
- 8 each ticket office and on all passenger trains, and when
- 9 practicable, printed upon the tickets. And any ticket
- 10 or check given in exchange for the unused portion of

- 11 a partially used ticket shall continue in force for the
- 12 full term of the original ticket as provided in said
- 13 section.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
