STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT for the abolition of the office of fish commissioner.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The office of commissioner of fisheries of 2 the State of Maine, shall be abolished, from and after 3 the fifteenth day of September, A. D. eighteen hun-4 dred and seventy-six, up to which time the present 5 commissioners shall as speedily as possible bring to a 6 termination all unsettled business connected with said 7 office.

SECT. 2. A sum not exceeding eight hundred dol-2 lars shall be appropriated for the purposes of this 3 act.

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SECT. 3. The said commissioners shall on the fif-2 teenth day of September, A. D. eighteen hundred and 3 seventy-six, turn over to the governor and council all 4 the records, documents, and other property of the 5 state, to be by them administered until otherwise pro-6 vided.

SECT. 4. All acts and parts of acts, resolves and 2 parts of resolves, inconsistent herewith, are hereby 3 repealed.
