## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend section eighty-seven of chapter eightytwo of the revised statutes, relating to evidence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Exception first of section eighty-seven of chapter
