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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
SEVENTY-SIX.

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AN ACT to amend section seven of chapter thirty of the  
revised statutes, relating to bounty on wild animals.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section seven of chapter thirty of the revised statutes,  
2 is hereby amended, by striking out the word “ legis-  
3 lature ” wherever it occurs in said section, and in-  
4 serting instead thereof the words “ governor and  
5 council,” so that said section, when amended, shall  
6 read as follows :

7 *Sect. 7.* Said certificates and receipts shall annually  
8 in the month of December be transmitted to the  
9 treasurer of state, and by him laid before the governor  
10 and council as early as convenient ; and when allowed

11 by the governor and council, shall be paid by the  
12 treasurer of state to such towns.
