STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT relating to written licenses or permits to cut timber and logs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Hereafter any assignment of a written permit, or a

- 2 conveyance of the logs and lumber cut or to be cut by
- 3 notice of the same, as security for money or supplies
- 4 to carry on the operation, and made on such written
- 5 permit, shall be valid notwithstanding such permit.
- 6 with such assignment and conveyance is not recorded
- 7 as mortgages of personal property are now required by
- 8 law to be; and nothing in this act shall be construed
- 9 to declare or imply that the law heretofore has been
- 10 otherwise.
