STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 3.] RESOLVE in favor of bridge across the Mattawamkeag river in the town of Haynesville, on the military road.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand dollars be
2 and hereby is appropriated to build two stone abut-
3 ments, and one stone pier under the bridge across the
4 Mattawamkeag river in the town of Haynesville, on
5 the military road ; to be expended under the direction
6 of the governor and council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge is a State bridge on the Military road between Mattawamkeag and Houlton. It is a good bridge, but the wooden foundations upon which it rests are so rotted away that it is in danger of destruction by the first heavy freshet that may occur. The State is bound by contract with the General Government to keep this road open.
