STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

[S. 67.] AN ACT to repeal an act entitled an act, relating to armories for military companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section eighty-six of the public laws of
- 2 the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five is hereby
- 3 amended by adding to said section the following: and
- 4 a reasonable compensation for rent of any such armory
- 5 or place of deposit, not exceeding the sum of one
- 6 hundred dollars per annum, may be allowed to the town
- 7 or city so furnishing such armory or place of deposit,
- 8 and paid from the state treasury.
 - SECT: 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
