## STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 29.] RESOLVE to provide for the uniforming of the enlisted men of the Maine volunteer militia, and for other military purposes.

Resolved, That the sum of ten thousand dollars be 2 and hereby is appropriated to be expended as required 3 by the provisions of section three, chapter twenty-nine, 4 public laws of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-5 nine, or in the repair and modification of the uniforms 6 and equipments now in use by the enlisted men of 7 the Maine volunteer militia, and the necessary ex-8 penses of a muster, at the direction of the governor 9 and council, and that the further sum of three thou-10 sand dollars be and is hereby appropriated, to be 11 expended under the direction of the governor and 12 council, for the purchase of tents and camp equipage.
