STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 33.] RESOLVE relating to the pay of the officers of
the state prison.

- Resolved*, That the yearly salary of the following officers of the state prison, shall be as follows :
- 3 Warden, three thousand dollars.
 - 4 Deputy warden, one thousand dollars.
 - 5 Clerk, six hundred dollars.
 - 6 Guards, four hundred and fifty dollars each.
 - 7 Physician, one hundred and fifty dollars.
 - 8 Chaplain, two hundred and fifty dollars.
 - 9 Gate keeper, three hundred dollars.
 - 10 Teacher, three hundred dollars.
