In Senate, February 8, 1876.

Ordered, That the Land Agent be directed to furnish to this Legislature a Tabular Statement of the amount of money and notes received by the State from sale of State lands, from sale of stumpage on State lands, and from sale of stumpage on settlers' lots in the several counties, since and including the year 1870. And also the number of lots of land deeded by said Land Agent by authority of legislative resolves to actual settlers and occupants of said lots; and also the number deeded to persons who were not in actual occupation, upon which settling duties in part or in whole have been waived, during said seven years.

To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives:

In compliance with an order of the Legislature, the undersigned has the honor to transmit the following statements which exhibit the amount of money and notes received by the State in the several counties since and including the year 1870, from the sale of State lands; from sale of stumpage of timber on State lands; and from sale of stumpage of timber on lands set apart for settlement. Also a statement of the number of lots conveyed by the Land Agent by authority of legislative resolves. In this statement the figures include about three thousand acres of land conveyed on surrender of certificates issued by the State to officers and soldiers of the Revolutionary war under resolves of March 17, 1837, and March 20, 1838; also several thousand acres granted in aid of building mills and to satisfy various claims against the State.

With respect to that part of the order asking for the number of lots conveyed under legislative resolves to actual settlers and occupants, and the number of lots conveyed to persons who were not in actual occupation, the undersigned has no means of answering the inquiry.
