STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the plantation of Wallagrass.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred dollars be,
2 and is hereby appropriated to aid in the construction
3 of a bridge over Wallagrass stream, in the plantation
4 of Wallagrass, in the county of Aroostook; the same
5 to be paid out of the state treasury to the treasurer of
6 Wallagrass, when the county commissioners of Aroos-
7 took shall have certified that a good and substantial
8 bridge has been built over said stream.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge is on the State road leading from Patten to Fort Kent; will cost some three or four hundred dollars. The valuation of plantation is a little over eleven thousand dollars. The above appropriation is thought sufficient to purchase that which cannot be had without money, and the inhabitants of said plantation will furnish all material that can be had without money.
