STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, relating to administrators, executors and trustees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Chapter sixty of the public laws of eighteen hundred
2 and seventy-six, is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the word "cases," in the third line, the words, "and
4 when they reside beyond the limits of this state, be-
5 fore a commissioner for the State of Maine or a United
6 States consul," so that said chapter, as amended, shall
7 read as follows :

8 "Administrators, executors and trustees, are hereby
9 authorized to make oath to their several accounts
10 before a justice of the peace in all cases, and when

11 they reside beyond the limits of this state, before a
12 commissioner for the State of Maine or a United States
13 consul, when no objection is made by parties interested
14 to the allowance of said account.”
