**RESOLVE** concerning an amendment of the constitution  
of Maine, relating to electors.

*Resolved*, That the following amendment to the con-  
2 stitution of this state be proposed for the action of the  
3 legal voters of this state, in the manner required by  
4 the constitution, to wit :

5 No person shall vote at any election unless he has  
6 paid a poll tax which shall within two years next pre-  
7 ceding such election, have been legally assessed upon  
8 him.
