

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE concerning an amendment of the constitution of Maine, relating to electors.

Resolved, That the following amendment to the con-

- 2 stitution of this state be proposed for the action of the
- 3 legal voters of this state, in the manner required by
- 4 the constitution, to wit:
- 5 No person shall vote at any election unless he has
- 6 paid a poll tax which shall within two years next pre-
- 7 ceding such election, have been legally assessed upon
- 8 him.
