STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Rufus F. Stone.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and is hereby
2 authorized to convey to Rufus F. Stone, lot number
3 sixty-seven in Chapman plantation, Aroostook county,
4 waiving further settling duties, *provided* said Stone
5 proves to the satisfaction of the land agent that he is
6 the actual owner of said lot.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled :

We the undersigned, respectfully represent that Rufus F. Stone of Washburn, Maine, is the lawful owner of the land certificate of lot No. 67 in Chapman plantation, in Aroostook county, Maine ; that all the road labor has been performed in payment for said lot to the acceptance of the Land Agent, with a small clearing and a comfortable dwelling house thereon ; that owing to the poor health of his family he is unable to establish his residence on the lot ; wherefore, we ask that an act be passed at the present legislature, authorizing the Land Agent to deed said lot to said Stone without the performance of further settling duties, and as in duty bound will ever pray.
