STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend part sixth of section fifty-five of chapter eighty-six of the revised statutes, relating to trustee process.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Part sixth of section fifty-five of chapter eighty-six 2 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding 3 thereto the following words, viz: "moreover, wages 4 of minor children and of women shall not in any case 5 be subject to trustee process on account of any debt 6 of parent or husband," so that said part sixth, when 7 amended, shall read as follows:

8 Sixth. By reason of any amount due from him to
9 the principal defendant as wages for his personal labor,
10 or that of his wife or minor children, for a time not

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11 exceeding one month next preceding the service of the 12 process, and not exceeding twenty dollars of the 13 amount due to him as wages for his personal labor; 14 and this shall not be exempt in any suit for necessaries 15 furnished him or his family; moreover, wages of 16 minor children and of women shall not in any case be 17 subject to trustee process on account of any debt of 18 parent or husband.
