STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section thirteen, chapter one hundred and thirty-three of the public laws of eighteen hundred seventy-three, relating to the punishment of criminals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirteen of chapter one hundred thirty-three

- 2 of the public laws of eighteen hundred seventy-three,
- 3 is hereby amended by striking out from the third line
- 4 the words "not exceeding three years," and inserting
- 5 in place thereof the words "for three years or less,"
- 6 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:
- 7 Sect. 13. In all criminal cases in this state where
- 8 the punishment as now provided by law may be im-
- 9 prisonment in the state prison for three years or less,
- 10 such punishment may be inflicted by any court having
- 11 jurisdiction of the offence or crime, in its discretion in
- 12 either of the jails aforesaid.
