STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for amendment to the constitution.

Resolved, Two-thirds of both branches of the legisla-2 ture concurring, that the constitution of the state shall 3 be amended as follows:

4 No city or town shall hereafter create any debt or 5 liability, which singly or in the aggregate with pre-6 vious debts or liabilities, shall exceed five per centum 7 of the last regular valuation of said city or town; 8 *provided*, *however*, that the adoption of this article 9 shall not be construed as applying to any fund received 10 in trust by said city or town, nor to any loan for the 11 purpose of renewing existing loans or for war, or to 12 temporary loans to be paid out of money raised by 13 taxation, during the year in which they are made.
