### STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-one, chapter eleven of the revised statutes of eighteen hundred seventy-one.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirty-one, chapter eleven of the revised stat-2 utes of eighteen hundred seventy-one is hereby amended 3 by inserting after the word "schools" in the second 4 line the words "for such a period of time as they may 5 determine," and by inserting after the word "districts" 6 in the tenth line the words "for said time," and by 7 inserting after the word "voters" in the eleventh line 8 the words "during said time, and at the expiration of 9 said time each of said districts shall resume its dis-10 trict organization unless a majority of the voters in 11 each district shall vote to continue the united district." 12 So that said section as amended shall read as follows:

#### HOUSE-No. 99.

13 Sect. 31. Two or more school districts may unite 14 for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a sys-15 tem of graded free schools for such a period of time as 16 they may determine, when a majority of the voters 17 present and voting at a meeting of each district, legally 18 called for the purpose, so determines; and the clerk of 19 each district shall forthwith furnish the town clerk 20 with a certified copy of such votes, and he shall enter 21 said votes upon the town records; and thereafter such 22 districts shall constitute one district, to be known by 23 the name that the inhabitants thereof adopt, and have all 24 the rights and powers, and be subject to all the liabilities 25 of other school districts for said time, and the town shall 26not alter or divide it without the consent of the majority of its voters during said time, and at the expiration of 27said time each of said districts shall resume its district 2829 organization unless a majority of the voters in each 30 district vote to continue the united district; and at its 31 annual meeting it may raise money for the support of 32 its schools, in addition to what it receives from the 33 town, and not exceeding three-fifths of that sum. And 34 any school district maintaining graded schools may 35 raise money for the support of its schools as provided 36 in this section for districts composed of two or more 37 districts.
