STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and forty-one of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, relating to cemeteries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section eight of chapter two hundred and forty-one
2 of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-
3 four, is hereby amended, by striking out all after the
4 word "it" in the fifth line, so that said section, as
5 amended, shall read as follows, to wit :

6 *Sect. 8.* The municipal officers of any town, are
7 hereby authorized to enlarge any public cemetery or
8 burying-ground within their town, on petition of
9 ten voters, by taking land of adjacent owners, to be
10 paid for by the town, when in their judgment public
11 necessity requires it.
