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STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Charles W. Porter.

Resolved, That when Charles W. Porter shall have 2 shown to the land agent that he is the lawful holder 3 of the land certificate of lot number ninety-five in 4 township I, range two, west from the east line of the 5 state, and shall have paid the balance of road labor 6 due on said lot, at the rate of fifty cents per acre, the 7 land agent be and he is hereby authorized to convey 8 to him said lot waiving all further settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

A land certificate of lot No. 95, Township I, Range 2, west from the east line of the State, was issued by the Land Agent August 27, 1870, to William Walton. The petitioner, Charles W. Porter, claims to be the lawful holder of said certificate. About thirty-five acres have been cleared, ten of which have been well laid down to grass, and a comfortable dwelling house on said lot. The petitioner has not established his own residence on the lot, but has a tenant residing on the same. He therefore prays that the Land Agent be authorized to convey said lot to him without requiring him to establish his residence thereon.
