STATE OF MAINE.

[H. R. 7.] RESOLVE for the appointment of a commission to reconstruct the laws relating to fisheries and the protection of fish.

Resolved, That the governor be instructed to appoint 2 a commission, consisting of five persons, whose duty 3 it shall be, without expense to the state, to codify, 4 amend or add to the laws relating to fisheries and the

5 protection of fish, as they in their judgment believe to 6 be for the best interests of the state, and report the

7 same to the next legislature.
