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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
SEVENTY-SEVEN.

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[S. 39.] AN ACT in relation to county attorneys.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Whenever the attorney general shall  
2 require it of any county attorney, the county attorney  
3 shall seasonably before the session of the law court,  
4 furnish to the attorney general a brief for the argu-  
5 ment of any state case from his county in said law  
6 court.

SECT. 2. When requested by the attorney general,  
2 each county attorney shall attend the sessions of the  
3 law court in his district, and assist in the presentation  
4 and argument of any state case or cases from his  
5 county.

SECT. 3. Such county attorney may be paid his  
2 necessary traveling expenses in such attendance. He  
3 shall present his account thereof to the attorney gen-  
4 eral who shall audit the same, and then the account  
5 shall be submitted to the governor and council, and  
6 when allowed by them shall be paid from the state  
7 treasury.
