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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
SEVENTY-SEVEN.

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[S. 19.] AN ACT to confirm the doings of school district number fifteen, in Berwick.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The doings of the meetings of the qualified voters of school district numbered thirteen; formerly fifteen, in the town of Berwick, held May seventh, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, and June sixth, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, are hereby confirmed and made valid.

SECT. 2. The acts and doings of the municipal officers of the town of Berwick in assessing and directing the collection of the tax, in pursuance of the votes passed at said meetings, are hereby confirmed and made valid.

SECT. 3. All usual legal liens and remedies for the  
2 collection of said tax, or any part thereof now remain-  
3 ing unpaid, shall be enjoyed and continue in force for  
4 the term of six months from and after the approval of  
5 this act.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon approval  
2 by the governor.
