STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Franklin Simmons, sculptor.

Resolved, That the treasurer of state be and is hereby 2 authorized and directed to pay to Franklin Simmons, 3 the sum of four thousand dollars, it being the balance 4 due him for a statue in marble of William King, the 5 first governor of this state, placed in the old rep-6 resentatives' hall at the national capital, in accordance 7 with a contract made with said Simmons by the state, 8 the second day of April, eighteen hundred and seventy-9 four; and said sum of four thousand dollars is hereby 10 appropriated for the purpose specified.
