STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend “an act granting to Ransom B. Abbott the right to establish and maintain a ferry between Sullivan and Hancock.”

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section two of “an act granting to Ransom B. 2 Abbott the right to establish and maintain a ferry 3 between Sullivan and Hancock,” approved February 4 ninth, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, by striking 5 out said section two, and inserting in place thereof the 6 following, so that said section shall read when amended, 7 as follows :

8 *Sect. 2.* The following rates of toll are hereby 9 established : for a single team or carriage, carrying not

10 exceeding two persons, thirty cents; for a double
11 team or carriage carrying not exceeding two persons,
12 forty cents; for each person exceeding two, five cents,
13 and for each additional horse ten cents; for a foot
14 passenger, ten cents; for a yoke of cattle and driver,
15 twenty-five cents; for the same with cart, thirty
16 cents; for an ox, cow or horse not driven in harness,
17 fifteen cents, and for each additional, ten cents, the
18 driver paying as a foot passenger; for sheep or swine,
19 three cents per head.
