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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE for the purchase of the Maine state year book and legislative manual.

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*Resolved,* That the secretary of state be authorized to contract for three hundred copies of the Maine State Year Book and Legislative Manual, for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one, at a cost not to exceed four hundred dollars, namely: fifty copies octavo, suitable for binding with the documents; one copy to be delivered by the secretary of state on or before the first day of May next, to each officer and member of the legislature, and the balance to the secretary of state for the heads of departments for their use. Also six hundred copies of the same for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, at a cost not to exceed eight hundred dollars, one hundred copies octavo, for binding with documents and for exchange with

16 other states, one copy to be delivered by the secre-  
17 tary of state on or before the first day of May,  
18 eighteen hundred and eighty-two, to each officer  
19 and member of the legislature, and the remainder  
20 to the heads of departments for their use.
