IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section two, chapter one hundred  
dred and five, of the private and special laws of  
eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, relating to the  
taking of alewives in Denny's river.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section second of said act is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after the word "Dennysville," in the fifth  
3 line, "and between the hours of sunset on Thurs-  
4 day and sunset on Saturday of each week, in that  
5 portion of the river between said fishway and the  
6 town of Meddybemps," so that said section as  
7 amended shall read as follows:

8 *Sect. 2.* The use of any means or implements  
9 for taking or destroying of alewives, or obstruct-  
10 ing their passage in said river, except between the

11 hours of sunrise on Monday and sunset on the fol-  
12 lowing Thursday of each week, in all that portion  
13 of the river below the fishway at Lincoln's mill  
14 in the town of Dennysville, and between the hours  
15 of sunset on Thursday and sunset on Saturday of  
16 each week in that portion of the river between said  
17 fishway and the town of Meddybemps, and between  
18 the hours of sunset on Monday and sunset on  
19 Friday of each week, in the town of Meddybemps,  
20 from the first day of January till the first day of  
21 August every year, is hereby prohibited.
