STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT amending section sixty-five of chapter forty-nine of the revised statutes, in relation to accident insurance policies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section .sixty-five of chapter forty-nine of the re-

- 2 vised statutes is hereby amended by adding after
- 3 the word "life" in the first line thereof the words
- 4 "and accident," so that said section as amended
- 5 shall read as follows:
- 6 Sect. 65. All life and accident policies and the
- 7 money due thereon are exempt from attachment,
- 8 and from all claims of creditors, during the life of
- 9 the insured, when the annual cash premium paid
- 10 does not exceed one hundred and fifty dollars; but

11 when it exceeds that sum and the premium was

12 paid by the debtor, his creditors have a lien on the

13 policies for such sum over one hundred and fifty

14 dollars per year as the debtor has paid for two

15 years, subject to any pledge or assignment thereof

16 made in good faith.
