STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to set off a part of the homestead farm of
Jonathan G. Record from Crystal plantation, and
annex the same to the town of Sherman.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. A part of the real estate of Jona-
2 than G. Record in Crystal plantation, in the county
3 of Aroostook, bounded and described as follows:
4 beginning at the southeast corner of Crystal plan-
5 tation, thence running northerly on the east line
6 thereof twenty-six rods, thence westerly to the east
7 line of land of Parker D. Young, thence southerly
8 to the south line of said Crystal plantation, thence
9 easterly on said south line to the place of begin-

10 ning, is hereby set off from said Crystal plantation,
11 and annexed to the town of Sherman.

SECT. 2. The said Jonathan G. Record and his
2 estate, set off as aforesaid, shall be holden to pay
3 all arrears of taxes which have been legally
4 assessed against him.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
