STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section one hundred and fifty-six,
chapter two hundred and twenty-five, public laws
of eighteen hundred and eighty.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section one hundred and fifty-six, chapter two
2 hundred and twenty-five, public laws of eighteen
3 hundred and eighty, is hereby amended as follows:
4 by inserting after the words "from time to time"
5 in the fifth line, the words "for a sum not exceed-
6 ing sixteen thousand dollars annually," so that said
7 section as amended shall read as follows:

8 *Sect. 156.* The commander-in-chief is hereby
9 authorized to establish and prescribe such rules,
10 regulations, forms and precedents as he may deem

11 proper for the use, government, and instruction of
12 the volunteer militia; and to carry into full effect
13 the provisions of this law, the governor is hereby
14 authorized to draw his warrant from time to time
15 for a sum not exceeding sixteen thousand dollars
16 annually, on any funds in the treasury not other-
17 wise expended, for the expense thereof.
