STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend item eighth, section fifty-four,
chapter eleven of the school laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Item eighth, section fifty-four, chapter eleven of
2 the statutes is hereby amended, by adding “or to
3 close or suspend any school on account of any con-
4 tagious disease, under such conditions as shall pre-
5 serve the equitable rights of both teachers and
6 school district,” so that said item shall read as
7 follows:

8 *Eighth.* Exclude from the public schools, if
9 they deem expedient, any person who is not vacci-
10 nated, though otherwise entitled by law to admis-
11 sion thereto, or to close or suspend any school on

12 account of any contagious disease, under such con-
13 ditions as shall preserve the equitable rights of
14 both teachers and school district.
