## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT for the speedy detection and punishment of crime.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives. in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Whenever there shall appear to the 2 governor probable cause to believe that the offence 3 of murder has been committed in this state, and 4 there is need of special investigation to discover 5 the perpetrators thereof, the governor may, upon 6 the application of the attorney general, or of the 7 county attorney of the county in which such offence 8 is believed to have been committed, authorize 9 either of said officers to employ some civil officer 10 or other suitable person to conduct such investiga-11 tion.

#### SENATE-No. 50.

SECT. 2. Such officer or person so employed 2 shall be paid his necessary expenses and reason-3 able compensation by the state for his services, 4 and his account therefor shall be approved by the 5 attorney general and such county attorney, and 6 audited by the governor and council.

#### HOUSE AMENDMENTS.

#### "A."

Amend section one by striking out all in said 2 section after the words "attorney general" in the 3 sixth line, and insert the words "authorize some 4 civil officer or other suitable person to conduct 5 such investigation."

#### "B."

Amend section two by striking out the word 2 "such," and inserting instead thereof the word 3 "the," and after "attorney" in the same line, the 4 words "for the county where the offence shall be 5 committed."
