STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-two of chapter eleven, of the revised statutes, relating to the location of school houses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representativs in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty-two of chapter eleven

- 2 of the revised statutes of eighteen hundred and
- 3 seventy-one, is hereby amended by adding after
- 4 the word "thereon" in the last line, the words "In
- 5 towns which have abolished the school districts
- 6 therein, the location for the erection or removal of
- 7 school houses, and necessary buildings and for
- 8 necessary play grounds shall be designated by vote-
- 9 of said town at any town meeting called for that
- 10 purpose," so that said section as amended shall read
- 11 as follows:

12 Sect. 32. At any district meeting called for the 13 purpose of removing a school house, or locating 14 one to be erected, if more than one-third of the 15 voters present and voting, object thereto, the clerk 16 shall make a record of the fact; and the municipal 17 officers, on written application of any three or more 18 of said voters, or any committee of the district 19 made within thirty days thereafterwards, shall as 20 soon as may be, appoint a time and place in the 21 district, to hear the parties and give such notice as 22 is required for a district meeting; and after such 23 hearing, they may decide where the school house 24 shall be placed; and shall within ten days give a 25 certificate of their determination to the clerk of 26 the district, who shall forthwith enter it on his 27 records, and the district shall proceed to erect, or 28 remove the school house as if determined by a 29 sufficient majority of the voters present at said 30 meeting; but no such officer residing in the district 31 shall have any voice in such determination; and 32 when a majority of them reside therein, or do not 33 agree, the superintending school committee shall 34 do all the duties herein required of the municipal 35 officers; and if the district refuses or neglects for 36 sixty days to carry into effect such determination,

- 37 the municipal officers or superintending school
- 38 committee at the expense of the district, shall if
- 39 need be, purchase a lot for said house, and cause it
- 40 to be erected or removed thereon. In towns which
- 41 have abolished the school districts therein the loca-
- 42 tion for the erection or removal of school houses
- 43 and necessary buildings, and for necessary play
- 44 grounds, shall be designated by vote of said town
- 45 at any town meeting called for that purpose.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved by the governor.
