RESOLVE in favor of an appropriation of roads in Indian township, county of Washington.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars

- 2 be, and is hereby appropriated yearly, for the years
- 3 eighteen hundred and eighty-three and eighty-four
- 4 on the Houlton and Baring road, across the Indian
- 5 township, in the county of Washington; also one
- 6 hundred and fifty dollars for each of said years, to
- 7 be expended on the road leading from said Houl-
- 8 ton and Baring road in said township, to the Grand
- 9 Lake stream, all of which is to be expended by the commissioners of Washington county.
