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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-THREE.

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AN ACT fixing a time when amendments to the con-  
stitution shall take effect.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Unless otherwise provided in the  
2 resolve submitting it, every constitutional amend-  
3 ment shall take effect and become part of the con-  
4 stitution, on the first Wednesday of January fol-  
5 lowing its adoption by the people.

SECT. 2. Within thirty days after it shall appear  
2 that a constitutional amendment has been adopted,  
3 the governor shall make proclamation thereof, and  
4 the secretary of state shall forthwith cause such  
5 proclamation to be published in the state paper,  
6 and it shall also be prefixed to the next volume of  
7 acts and resolves.
