## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT fixing a time when amendments to the constitution shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Unless otherwise provided in the
- 2 resolve submitting it, every constitutional amend-
- 3 ment shall take effect and become part of the con-
- 4 stitution, on the first Wednesday of January fol-
- 5 lowing its adoption by the people.
  - Sect. 2. Within thirty days after it shall appear
- 2 that a constitutional amendment has been adopted,
- 3 the governor shall make proclamation thereof, and
- 4 the secretary of state shall forthwith cause such
- 5 proclamation to be published in the state paper,
- 6 and it shall also be prefixed to the next volume of
- 7 acts and resolves.
