STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT additional to chapter one hundred and twenty-four of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three, relating to free high schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

When a town has voted to establish and maintain 2 a free high school under the provisions of this act, 3 it may authorize its assessors and superintending 4 school committee to deduct from the money to be 5 apportioned to the district in which such school is 6 to be located, a sum not exceeding that raised by 7 the town for the support of such school, and ap-8 portion the same among the other districts, in such 9 manner as in their judgment may be required.
