#### STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making an appropriation in favor of the Maine General Hospital for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-three and eighteen hundred and eighty-four.

Resolved, That the sum of ten thousand dollars

- 2 be and hereby is appropriated towards defraying
- 3 the expenses of the Maine General Hospital for the
- 4 year ending December thirty-one, eighteen hundred
- 5 and eighty-three and the year ending December
- 6 thirty-one, eighteen hundred and eighty-four; and
- 7 that the governor be and hereby is authorized to
- 8 draw his warrant quarterly, commencing March
- 9 thirty-one, eighteen hundred and eighty-three, for
- 10 the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars for the
- 11 above purpose.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Maine General Hospital has greatly increased its field of usefulness. The number of patients has been larger than ever before, and the number of poor and unfortunate who have availed themselves of its benefits has greatly increased. The report of the directors, in possession of each member, fully sets forth the facts on this subject.

The amount called for in the resolve is the same as called for in the two years last past and for many years before.
