STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to the employment of teachers for
public schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. All teachers for the public schools of
2 this state shall hereafter be employed by the sup-
3 erintending school committees or supervisors of the
4 several cities, towns, and plantations.

SECT. 2. When any teacher shall have been
2 employed as aforesaid, it shall be the duty of the
3 superintending school committee or supervisor to
4 give to the agent of the district for which said
5 teacher is employed, written notice of the name of
6 the person so employed and of the compensation
7 agreed upon.

SECT. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with this act, are hereby repealed.
