STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT entitled an act to fix the dimensions of "ship knees," and to provide for the inspection and marking thereof.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The dimensions of ship knees shall² 2 be not less than the following specifications, to-wit:
