## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to condense and amend section one, of chapter ninety-two, of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one, of chapter ninety-two, of the public

- 2 laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three, is
- 3 hereby condensed and amended by inserting there-
- 4 in the words, "and for the erection and mainten-
- 5 ance of monuments, and for the benefit of public
- 6 cemeteries and lots therein," so that the same sec-
- 7 tion, condensed and amended, shall be as follows:
- 8 Sect. 1. Any city or town may receive money
- 9 by donation or legacy, in trust, for benevolent,
- 10 religious, or educational purposes, and for the

- 11 erection and maintenance of monuments, and for
- 12 the benefit of public cemeteries and lots therein;
- 13 provided that the city or town shall lawfully con-
- 14 sent.
